




Check the map and route schedule to determine your collection day. To report missed pick-ups call ProVyro at 855-ProVyro or 715-513-6686. Please place the enclosed stickers on your calendar as a reminder of your recycling day.

Your recyclables must be set out by 5 am or the night before your scheduled collection day by the curb or your recyclables may not be picked up until your next scheduled day.

If a holiday occurs during a given week, collection of recyclables for the remainder of the week will be picked up one day late. Holidays include New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas. The route schedule has been adjusted for holidays.

If you live on a recycling boundary line, you fall into the route on your side of the street.

- Even addresses on North side of street
- Even addresses on West side of street
- Odd addresses on South side of street
- Odd addresses on East side of street

YARD WASTE SITE: Residents may dispose of yard waste (leaves, grass clippings and small brush) at the Chippewa Falls City Shop at Riverside Drive on designated days. For more information regarding the yard waste site please call 715-720-6971.

WASTE OIL RECYCLING SITE: Waste motor oil should be disposed of properly at the Chippewa Falls City Shop, 5 Riverside Drive. Recycle engine oil only. Do not mix the oil with any other substances such as antifreeze or paint thinner. Take your empty containers home with you. 24 hour drop-off available with outside dump.

PAPER, CARDBOARD & CARTONS

Break down all large items to maximize space.



Envelopes & Junk Mail Newspapers Magazines Office Paper Products



Phone Books Flattened Cardboard Milk & Juice Cartons Cereal & Food/ Beverage Boxes



Hardcover Books (covers removed) Wrapping Paper (no foil or ribbon) Empty Paper Towel/ Toilet Paper Rolls

No wax-coated paper or fiberboard

METAL

Rinse clean.



Aluminum & Steel Cans Aluminum Pie Tins Empty Aerosol Cans Clean Aluminum foil



Small Metal Household Appliances Small Metal Plumbing Fixtures & Pipes, Misc. Scrap (limit 2ft x 2ft; 35lbs) Metal Pots, Pans & Utensils

No E-waste, TVs, or computer items

PLASTIC CONTAINERS

Rinse clean, remove & discard plastic lids & caps.



All plastic bottles & containers marked #1 - #7

(plastic food & beverage containers, milk/water/juice bottles, detergent/shampoo bottles, yogurt cups)



No plastic bags/film, Styrofoam®, syringes, motor oil bottles

GLASS

Rinse clean, remove and recycle metal lids & caps.



Brown, green & clear glass bottles & jars


No windows, mirrors, ceramics, light bulbs

PLACE ALL RECYCLABLES LOOSE IN YOUR RECYCLING CART

Please do not bag recyclables!

**If you are moving from your home, please leave the recycling cart there.*

Leave 3-4 feet between carts and mailboxes, poles, vehicles, or other objects.

Place cart so the lid opening is facing the street. Be sure there are no obstructions in front of the cart.

The purpose of the recycling contract is for the hauler to collect and transfer recyclables from single family homes, 2-4 unit residential dwellings and mobile home parks in the City of Chippewa Falls.

The City of Chippewa Falls promotes recycling by providing curbside pickup for residents in the City. The City has awarded the exclusive single contract for curbside household recycling collection to ProVyro.
