MINUTES OF THE PLANCOMMISSION MEETING CITY OF CHIPPEWA FALLS MONDAY, JULY 12, 2021-6:30 PM


The Plan Commission met in City Hall on Monday, July 12, 2021 at 6:30P.M. Present were Commissioners, Greg Misfeldt, Mike Tzanakis, Dennis Doughty, Beth Ameberg, Jerry Smith, Alderperson Jason Hiess, Vice-Chairperson Tom Hubbard, Secretary Rick Rubenzer and Mayor Greg Hoffman. Dave Cihasky and Dan Varga were absent. Also attending was Bill Proud representing A-1 Properties LLC.

- 1. <u>Motion</u> by Doughty, seconded by Smith to approve the minutes of the June 7, 2021 Plan Commission meeting. All present voting aye. Motion carried.
- 2. Bill Proud of A-1 Properties LLC appeared to request that Special Use Permit Ordinance No. 2010-16 be amended to include additional uses of craft fairs, car shows, flea markets, mid-week farmer's markets and an outdoor drive-in theater along with a revised site plan. Mr. Proud gave the Plan Commission an update on the Wisconsin Renaissance Faire grounds and the Eagle Ridge Campground. He stated that the Olson's were interested in installing a movie theater screen and mobile projector. He noted that the campground had experienced significant growth the past few years and was up to sixty-six seasonal campers. Director of Public Works Rubenzer stated that changed conditions of Special Use Permit Ordinance No. 2010-16 were highlighted on the attached DRAFT Ordinance 2021-?. The plan Commission discussed each of the highlighted conditions. Director of Public Works Rubenzer stated that Police Chief Kelm, Clerk Givens, Inspector Lasiewicz and himself had reviewed the changes and that he didn't believe a new public hearing process should be required. He continued that Mr. Proud was working with Clerk Givens on alcohol and music permits for the site and that the revised Developer's Agreement would have the details and requirements for fencing, armbands and emergency operations plans. Commissioner Hiess asked about an additional ingress/egress access road. Mr. Proud responded that there was a connector road that had been constructed in 2021, that connected the campground with the Renaissance Faire site that would also provide an alternative access road. Motion by Smith, seconded by Hubbard to recommend the City Council consider the attached revised Special Use Permit 2010-16 with changes highlighted and corresponding revised site plan without the necessity of a new public hearing notice and hearing process. All present voting aye. Motion carried.
- 3. <u>Motion</u> by Hiess, seconded by Hubbard to adjourn. All present voting aye. Motion carried. The Plan Commission adjourned at 6:56 P.M.
