SUMMARY

The Public Utilities, Streets, and Engineering Divisions of the Public Works Department are responsible for the design, survey, construction, inspection, maintenance, and record keeping for public works projects, streets, and municipal facilities. A City Mechanic will perform skilled mechanical work in the maintenance and repair of city vehicles including, but not limited to trucks, mechanical equipment, and heavy motorized units.

To perform this job successfully an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. - Repairs and overhauls city trucks, vehicles, and other automotive equipment. This includes diesel machinery.
- Diagnose, troubleshoot, service, maintain, and repair components of cars, light and heavy trucks, truck equipment, trailers, tractors, heavy equipment and machinery including gasoline and diesel engines, manual and automatic transmissions, clutches, drive trains, differentials, brake systems, hydraulic systems, pneumatic systems, exhaust, electrical, steering, cooling, air conditioning, suspension, frames, lighting and communications systems.
- Mount, dismount and repair snow plows, tailgate spreaders, hitches, braces and other machinery and equipment attachments. Maintains work area in a safe and clean manner.
- Repairs, and reconditions, pumps, transmissions, differentials, distributors, hydraulics, and electrical systems.
- Operates a variety of machines and equipment used in general mechanical automotive repair and maintenance work.
- Cuts or welds metal by electric, acetylene, wire feed methods.
- Occasionally performs autobody repair work.
- Respond to weather situations including snow and ice events, high water, washouts, and others as directed.
- Safely traverse the terrain and thorough understanding of limitations of equipment.
- Perform minor maintenance and repair to Street Department buildings.
- Other duties or functions may be assigned.
