### ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH PROCEDURES AND CRITERIA FOR ALLOWING ALTERNATIVE FORMS OF SWORN TESTIMONY AT BOARD OF REVIEW (BOR) HEARINGS

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CHIPPEWA FALLS, WISCONSIN DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That § 1.10 of the Chippewa Falls Municipal Code, regarding Board of Review, and which 1. presently provides as follows:

### 1.10 - BOARD OF REVIEW.

(3) FIRST MEETING. The first meeting of the Board of Review shall not be less than 4 hours and shall be from 8 a.m. to 12 noon. If the assessment roll is not complete, the Board may adjourn as is necessary to complete the roll. Notice of the meeting shall be posted on the meeting room door advising as to when the Board shall reconvene.

be amended to provide as follows:

- (3) FIRST MEETING. The City Assessor shall set the date and time of the first meeting of the Board of Review within the confines of the statutes. If the assessment roll is not complete, the Board may adjourn as is necessary to complete the roll. Notice of the meeting shall be posted on the meeting place door advising as to when the Board shall reconvene.
- Sec. 70.47(8), Wis. Stats. authorizes the Board of Review to consider requests from a property owner or the property owner's representative to appear before the Board under oath by telephone or to submit written statements under oath to the Board of Review. In order for a property owner or property owner's representative to submit a request to testify by phone or submit a sworn written statement, he or she must first comply with the following procedures:
  - a. The legal requirement to provide notice of intent to appear at BOR must be satisfied; and
  - b. An Objection Form for Real Property Assessment (PA-115A) must be completed and submitted to the BOR as required by law.

After the two requirements outlined above have been met, a Request to Testify by Telephone or Submit a Sworn Written Statement at Board of Review (Form PA-814) may be submitted to the City Clerk. Such requests must be submitted in time to be considered by the Board at the first meeting of the BOR.

- (5) CRITERIA TO BE CONSIDERED. The Board may consider any or all of the following factors when deciding whether to grant or deny the request:
  - a. The requester's stated reason(s) for the request as indicated on the PA-814
  - b. Fairness to the parties
  - c. Ability of the requester to procure in person oral testimony and any due diligence exhibited by the requester in procuring such testimony
  - d. Ability to cross examine the person providing the testimony
  - e. The BOR's technical capacity to honor the request
  - f. Any other factors that the Board deems pertinent to deciding the request

# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE NONTHREADED CONNECTION SIZE OF FIRE DEPARTMENT PUMP-IN CONNECTIONS, SECTIONS 5.13(2) (a) & (b) OF THE CHIPPEWA FALLS MUNICIPAL CODE

- (2) PUMP-IN CONNECTION REQUIREMENTS.
  - a. <u>New Construction.</u> New building construction projects with fire sprinkler systems shall install a single 4-inch (100mm) nonthreaded connection, also known as a Storz connection, for the Fire Department pump-in connection.
  - b. Existing Sprinkler Systems. Any alteration or addition to an existing fire sprinkler system, shall necessitate the replacement of any existing single 2½-inch threaded or double 2½-inch threaded Fire Department pump-in connection, with a new single 4-inch (100mm) Storz nonthreaded Fire Department connection.

#### 5.13 FIRE DEPARTMENT PUMP-IN CONNECTIONS.

- (2) PUMP-IN CONNECTION REQUIREMENTS.
  - a. New Construction.   - b. Existing Sprinkler Systems. Any alteration or addition to an existing fire sprinkler system, shall necessitate the replacement of any existing single 2½-inch threaded or double 2½-inch threaded

Fire Department pump-in connection, with a new single 5-inch (125mm) Storz nonthreaded Fire Department connection, with a 22½ degree angle towards the ground, if the bottom of the connection is higher than 18 inches off the ground.

- 2. Remove existing driveways and replace them with concrete driveways in the public right of way.
- 3. Removal and replacement of deficient street surfacing.

### NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHIPPEWA FALLS, WISCONSIN, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the report of the Director of Public Works pertaining to the construction of the above described public improvements, including plans and specifications and proposed special assessments therefore, (as modified) (as prepared) is hereby adopted and approved.
- 2. That payment for said improvements be made by assessing the cost to the abutting property as indicated in said report.
- 3. That the properties against which these special assessments are levied are benefited by these improvements and that the costs shown on the accepted report, representing an exercise of police power, are true and correct and have been determined on a reasonable basis and are hereby confirmed.
- 4. That the special assessments be paid to the City Treasurer as provided by Section 3.08 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin, as amended by Ordinance

#09-06 adopted April 7, 2009, which provides for cash payments and installment payments with interest as follows: (A) If the amount due is less than \$500, a single payment; (B) If the amount due is at least \$500 but less than \$2,500, five (5) annual installments with deferred payments bearing interest at the rate of 0.5% over the city general obligation bond (GOB) rate on a per annum basis on the unpaid balance, and (C) If the amount due is \$2,500 or more, ten (10) annual installments with deferred payments bearing interest at the rate of 0.5% over the city general obligation bond (GOB) rate on a per annum basis on the unpaid balance.

- 5. That the City Clerk is directed to publish this Resolution as a Class I notice and to mail a copy of this Resolution to every interested person whose post office address is known or can be ascertained with reasonable diligence. Further, that a copy of City Ordinance 8.06 (2) (e), which prohibits cuts in the new street surface, be mailed to each abutting owner.
- 6. That the Public Works Director is hereby ordered to cause these improvements to be constructed by contract and City Forces in accordance with said report.
