Heartland will charge \$2,500 to perform the demolition of these five buildings. Dick Hebert cites various reasons including safety & efficiency for having Heartland perform this work. As there will be funds remaining the LP budget, he recommends using the excess funds in that budget item to pay for this work. Motion by Beth Arneberg/Dale Berg to have Heartland perform demolition of the buildings for the sum of \$2,500.00 and pay for that demolition with funds remaining in the LP gas budget line item. Motion carried.
    - Construction Schedule. Dick Hebert distributed the tentative construction schedule. Carmen Muenich questioned Dick about his plan to keep the

- public apprised of the progression of the project. Dick indicates he is thinking of having a groundbreaking ceremony and intends to keep the public informed and involved through the construction process. Beth suggests updating the Campaign page with construction news.
- 2016 Urban Forestry Grant Application. Dick Hebert presents proposal b. agreement from West Central Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission (WCWRPC) for preparation of DNR Urban Forestry Grant Application. Under the agreement, WCWRPC would coordinate with the City of Bloomer, City of Chippewa Falls, and Chippewa County Department of Land Conservation & Forestry Management. The application would request funding for development of inventory and Emerald Ash Borer Readiness and Response Plans. It is a 50% matching grant. It is being proposed that the City of Chippewa Falls pay for \$1,250 of the \$4,000 cost to prepare and apply for the grant. Dick is recommending we pay for the \$1,250.00 out of the tree trimming budgeted line item. Discussed covering the 50% match out of timber sales at the well fields by Casper Park, at Summit Ave Park and/or Erickson Park. Motion by Rob Kiefer/Dale Berg to approve agreement with West Central Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission to prepare and apply for DNR Urban Forestry Grant Application and pay \$1,250.00 of the cost out of the tree trimming budget line item. Motion carried.

SECTION 1: <u>Territory Annexed.</u> In accordance with sec. 66.0217(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes and the Petition for Direct Annexation that was served upon the City Clerk for the City of Chippewa Falls on August 21, 2015 by personal service, signed by the sole owner of a parcel of real property of which said population of said parcel is zero. The following described territory which is located in the Town of Lafayette, Chippewa County, Wisconsin, is hereby annexed to the City of Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin:

Lot Nine (9), Block Three (3) of Tropicana City, Town of Wheaton, Chippewa County, Wisconsin.

Said parcel is subject to easements and restrictions of record.

**SECTION 2:** Compliance with Statute. Said Petition of Sole Property Owner for Direct Annexation is a proper petition for Direct Annexation in that said petition stated the purpose for said annexation, contained a legal description of the territory to be annexed, included a scale map of the territory to be annexed which is unincorporated and is contiguous to the City of Chippewa Falls; and

**WHEREAS,** the Petition for Annexation of the Territory legally described in Section 1, was properly served upon Mark A. Christenson, Town Clerk, for the Town of Wheaton, on August 24, 2015, by certified mail; and

WHEREAS, the Petition (Petition File No. 13883) for Annexation of the Territory legally described in Section 1 was properly served upon Erich Schmidtke of the State of Wisconsin Department of Administration; and

WHEREAS, approval by the State of Wisconsin Department of Administration for the proposed annexation finding it to be in the public interest is pending but approval is expected; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance is subject to and contingent upon the ultimate approval and advice of the State of Wisconsin Department of Administration; and

WHEREAS, The Common Council of the City of Chippewa Falls believes that annexation of the Territory, legally described in Section 1, in the Town of Wheaton, Chippewa County, Wisconsin, to the City of Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin, is in the public interest.

**SECTION 3:** <u>Effect of Annexation.</u> From and after the date of this ordinance the Territory legally described in Section 1 shall be a part of the City of Chippewa Falls for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming into or residing within said territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the City of Chippewa Falls.

**SECTION 4:** Zoning Classification. Upon recommendation of the Plan Commission, the Territory annexed to the City of Chippewa Falls by this Ordinance is designated to be a part of the following district of the City for zoning purposes and subject to all provisions of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Chippewa Falls:

# R-1B, SINGLE FAMILY

**SECTION 5:** <u>Ward Designation</u>. The Territory described in Section 1 of this Ordinance is hereby made a part of Ward 3a of the City of Chippewa Falls, either presently existing or to be established by Ordinance, subject to all other ordinances, rules and regulations of the City, County, and State governing wards.

**SECTION 6:** Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

**SECTION 7:** Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.







Dear Ms. Bauer:

As you know, Statewide Services, Inc. administers the claims for the League of Wisconsin Municipalities Mutual Insurance, which provides the insurance coverage for the City of Chippewa Falls. We are in receipt of the above-captioned claims regarding damages each claimant sustained when a tree or tree branches fell onto their respective properties given a heavy

storm that hit the City on 07/18/05. These claims were reported to us individually, and I consolidated them into this **one claim** which will register as **one occurrence** resulting from the storm.

A discussed, our investigation has revealed that the City was not negligent for this incident. Therefore, we recommend that the City disallow these claims pursuant to the Wisconsin Statute for disallowance of claim 893.80(1g). The disallowance of the claims in this manner will shorten the statute of limitations period to six months.

These four losses occurred when separate City trees or tree branches near the respective addresses fell over in heavy winds to cause the damage to each claimant as noted above. After speaking with Parks and Recreations Director, Dick Hebert, along with Street Department Manager, Rick Ruf, none of the trees in question were compromised or diseased, and the losses are purely related to the heavy storm—an "Act of God"—which the City could not control. Therefore, we recommend the claims be disallowed as the City bears no liability for the unfortunate losses.

Note: if it is proven that one—or all—of the trees in question were compromised to a degree and/or did have evidence of being diseased, the claims should still be disallowed as City staff had no prior notice of any problems with the trees in order to take a preventive measure. Again, I understand that none of the trees in question showed signs of being compromised or diseased.

I have enclosed a sample Notice of Disallowance for your use, should you choose to use it, or you may use your own. Please send your disallowance, on your letterhead, directly to each of the claimants at the above listed addresses. This should be sent certified or registered (restricted) mail and must be received by the claimants within 120 days after you received the claim. Please send me a copy of your letters for our file.
