

<u>Minutes</u> <u>Committee #3</u>

Transportation, Construction, Public Safety and Traffic

Committee #3 met Thursday, February 2, 2012 at 3:00 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers, 30 West Central Street, Chippewa Falls, WI.

Attendees: Bill Hicks, Mike Hanke, CW King, Jane Lardahl, Public Works Director Rick Rubenzer, Captain John Liddell and Fire Chief Tom Larson.

The meeting was called to order at 3:00 PM.

Item 1. Consider Amending Chapter 7 – Traffic Code of the City of Chippewa Falls Municipal Code and make recommendation to Common Council.

Motion by King/Hicks, all present voting aye, to recommend the City Council Amend Chapter 7 – Traffic Code of the City of Chippewa Falls to allow pickup and drop off of Students in a segment along the north side of Miles Street between the west property line of #1229 Miles Street and Terrill Street. **Motion carried**

The proposed new wording is attached.

Item 2. Consider approving the six month contract extension of the Chippewa Falls/Eau Claire West Central Regional Hazardous Materials Response Team with Wisconsin Emergency Management (January 1, 2012 – June 30, 2012) and make recommendation to Common Council.

Motion by King/Hanke, all present voting aye, to recommend the City Council approve the six month contract extension with Wisconsin Emergency Management. **Motion carried**

Item 3. Discuss high consequence hazardous material facilities in the immediate Chippewa Falls area.

Fire Chief Tom Larson presented Committee 3 with a summary of Facilities in the immediate Chippewa Falls area. The information was obtained from Chippewa County Emergency Management Director Dennis Brown. There are 29 Planning Facilities that have threshold limits or 500 pounds or more of one of 400 extremely hazardous substances as defined by the US Federal Government. There are 35 reporting Facilities that have 10,000 pounds of any hazardous material substances. The information sheet is attached.

Committee 3 will be inviting Mr. Dennis Brown to a meeting to discuss participation by the City in defining current safety requirements and future zoning of facilities within immediate area of the City boundaries.
