

COMMITTEE #1 REVENUES, DISBURSEMENTS, WATER AND WASTEWATER October 17, 2017

Committee #1 - Revenues, Disbursements, Water and Wastewater met on Tuesday, October 17, 2017 at 9:00 AM in the Council Chambers, City Hall, 30 West Central Street, Chippewa Falls, WI.

Committee Members present: Rob Kiefer, John Monarski, and Paul Nadreau Mayor/Other Council Members present: None

Others present: Finance Manager/Treasurer Lynne Bauer, Director of Public Works/City Engineer/Utilities Manager Rick Rubenzer, Parks and Recreation Director Dick Hebert, Wastewater Supervisor George Hobbs, and City Clerk Bridget Givens.

Call to Order: 9:00 AM

1. Consider bids for HVAC project at the Wastewater Treatment Plant. Possible recommendations to Council.

Wastewater Supervisor Hobbs explained to the Committee why the roofing proposal was not included as part of the HVAC project. The roof was identified as needing repair in 2015 at which time Hobbs obtained proposals for the work. In 2016 the heating unit failed which then required the complete HVAC project. Hobbs requested that Strand Associates, Inc. not include the roof repair as part of the HVAC project as proposals for the roofing work had already been received. It was anticipated that keeping the roof separate would help keep engineering costs down.

Motion by Kiefer/Monarski to recommend Council approve awarding the bid for the HVAC project at the Wastewater Treatment Plant to low bidder, J.F. Ahern Co., in the amount of \$518,400. **All present voting aye, motion carried.**

2. Consider roofing proposal at the Wastewater Treatment Plant. Possible recommendations to Council.

This item was discussed under Agenda Item No. 1.

Motion by Monarski/Nadreau to recommend Council approve the proposal submitted by Tek Roofing Inc. for roof repairs at the Wastewater Treatment Plant in accordance with the letter received from Strand Associates. **All present voting aye, motion carried.**

3. Review preliminary budget data and issues affecting the budget. Possible recommendations to the Council.

Finance Manager/Treasurer Bauer advised that she is working with the agent on possible options for health insurance as the City received a higher than anticipated renewal. Most of the operational budgets have been reviewed, and roughly \$75K in omitted budget requests have been received. The departments will be asked to present their budgets at the next two meetings.

The City's net new construction is 1.73%, which is roughly \$80K. It is anticipated that additional revenues from ambulance service will be used to offset the addition of the Battalion Chief position. Primary factors to consider this year will be wage increases and health insurance increases.

Digital budget information will be provided to the Committee prior to next Tuesday's meeting.

No action taken.

4. Adjournment.

Motion by Monarski/Nadreau to adjourn at 9:15 am. All present voting aye, motion carried.

Bids for the above-referenced project were opened on September 8, 2017. Two bids were received with the resulting bid tabulation enclosed. The low bid of \$518,400 was less than ENGINEER's opinion of probable construction cost.

J.F. Ahern Co. of Menomonie, Wisconsin was the apparent low bidder at \$518,400. The bid included a bid bond for 10 percent and Addendum No. 1 was acknowledged.

Strand Associates, Inc.[®] has previously worked with J.F. Ahern Co. Based on our previous experience with this contractor, we have found J.F. Ahern Co. to be responsible.

We suggest that you consider evaluating J.F. Ahern Co.'s financial status prior to award and other information submitted to you as required by Article 19.05.2 found in the Instructions to Bidders of the Contract Documents.


